ORDER

The property assessment has now been certified by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Revenue, Office of Property Valuation and permissible ad valorem tax rates and revenue for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 established for Henderson County in accordance with KRS 68.245 through 68.249.

BE IT ORDERED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Henderson, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that the following tax rates for 2020-2021 are hereby set:

FURTHER, BE IT ORDERED, that a three (3) cents per acre tax be levied on all privately owned timberland in Henderson County, which is required to be listed for taxation and credited to the Forest Fire Protection Account.

On first reading motion was made by Magistrate Southard and seconded by Magistrate Berry, to adopt the aforesaid rates, 12.8 real estate tax rate and 18.4 personal property tax, that Inventory in transit be exempt and further it is ordered that all tax rates read aloud as set out herein, be and are hereby set and accepted.
