## Discussion and Review of County Ordinances – Judge Schneider

Chapters 182, 191, 208 & 210 were reviewed by the Magistrates, Judge Schneider and County Attorney Steve Gold.


All agreed with the redline changes to Chapter 182 which eliminates Article II (Parks & Recreation Board). County Engineer Bill Hubiak stated that he could not remember that last time a Parks Board meeting was held (over 5 years ago) and did not even know who was actually on the board.


It was suggest to make some minor changes to Chapter 191 and add scrap metals, copper and any other metals that may be identified to the description of Precious Metals. All agreed.

There were no suggested changes to Chapter 208- Solid Waste. Magistrate McCollom brought up the possibility of having mandatory trash pickup in the county like the city has. Discussion ensued on the pros and cons of this and also the problem of dumping and littering in the county. Magistrate McCollom & Puttman both stated that they have constituents that don't feel that it's fair that their residents have to pay to have their garbage removed while a county resident can take his to the transfer station at no cost. Judge Schneider stated there are a number of items that county subsidizes that happen inside city limits that benefit city residents also. All agreed that no changes needed to be made to this chapter at this time.

No changes were suggested to Chapter 210 – Special Events.

There being no further business to come before the court, Magistrate Puttman made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Magistrate McCollom.
